## SNACK TIME RECIPE!

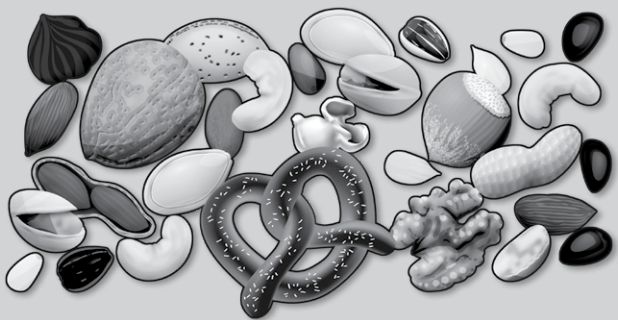
